Starter Bikes Coordinator for the Atlanta Bicycle Coalition

Description

Starter Bikes is a partnership between Georgia Tech's Students Organizing for Sustainability (SOS) and the Atlanta Bicycle Coalition (ABC). SOS volunteers repair abandoned bicycles and donate them to ABC for distribution to those in need of affordable transportation. To cover the costs of repairs and storage space, ABC will sell the bicycles for \$50-150, with discounts for volunteers based on hours worked.

We are seeking an intern to coordinate volunteer efforts, market the program to potential customers and volunteers, and manage direct and consignment sales.

Responsibilities

- Volunteer Recruitment and Management
- Marketing
- Sales

Successful candidate will be:

- Committed to minimum of 10 hours per week for 6 months
- Well-organized
- A good communicator
- Energetic; comfortable working with diverse groups of people
- Motivated to learn new skills independently

This position is an unpaid internship with the opportunity for credit (depending on the institution). All applicants are welcome and one need not be a student to apply.
